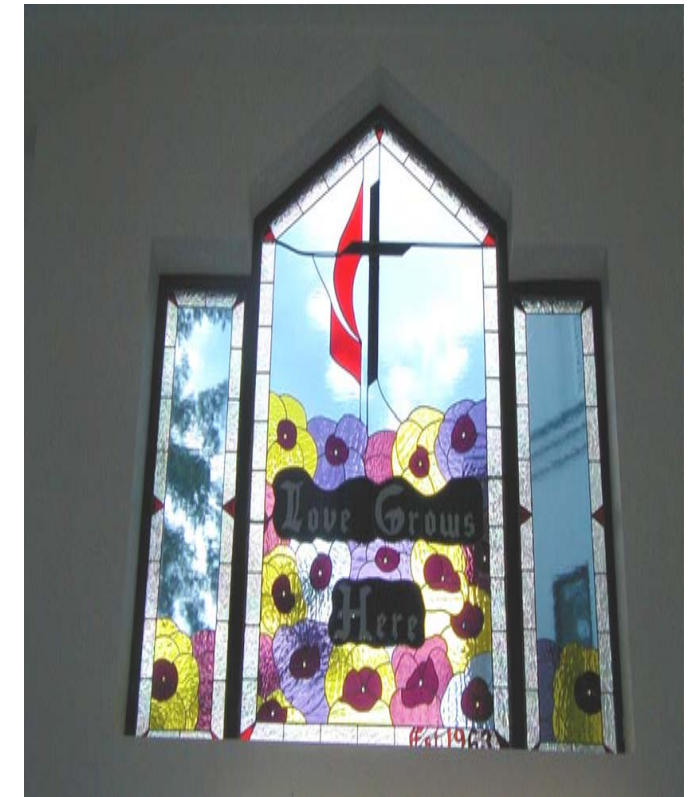
SUNDAY GOOD NEWS
